

During the year 2022 BEBA continued supporting families within person sessions at the Ojai clinic in California as well as with Zoom or phone sessions for families in other areas of the country and the world. Families attend sessions for as long as they want/need to resolve issues and traumatic imprinting and to explore effective parenting skills so they can continue on their own with occasional support.

Family Sessions at the BEBA Clinics

BEBA Facilitators provided a total of 97 sessions in 2022 (82 sessions in 2021) averaging 57 minutes.

- The Ojai BEBA Clinic provided 94 family sessions of which most of them were in person and sometimes they were on the phone or Zoom.
- Online BEBA Clinic provided 8 family sessions which were Zoom sessions.

The family clinic continues operating on a sliding scale between \$75/hour and \$140/hour. Clients were charged an average of \$88.77/ hour.

25 families came to BEBA in 2022 (21 in 2021): 32 children and their parents. 12 of these families started in 2022. Between January 1993, when BEBA started, and Dec 31, 2022, BEBA has served a total of 280 families.

Demographics of Families in the Family Clinic

The following is a breakdown of families seen in 2022 by annual income:

- 60% of the sessions were with families with annual incomes between \$60,000 to \$75,000.
- 16% of the sessions were with families with annual incomes between \$75,000 to \$100,000.
- 24% of the sessions were with families with annual incomes between \$100,000 to \$140,000.

Ojai Clinic

Since September 2004, BEBA has operated a clinic in Ojai at the home of BEBA Facilitator, Director and Board Member, Tara Blasco. Tara offered sessions there during the year. The rent for this branch of BEBA is provided free of charge. It consists of a playroom complete with gym mats, tunnels, toys, pillows etc.

Clinical Staff

The clinical staff included 11 people: 1 Clinic Director, 3 Facilitators, 1 Bookkeeper & Administrator, 1 Assistant and 6 Volunteer Videographers/Layer of support facilitators.

Our beloved Raymond Castellino, D.C., RCST® co-founder and co-director of the BEBA clinic passed away on December 13, 2020. We miss him immensely and have continued doing the work to support families that he so beautifully developed over the years.

Tara Blasco, Ph.D., RCST® is the solo Director offering her services in this capacity on a volunteer basis. Tara Blasco continued being a paid facilitator offering sessions at the Ojai clinic and online.

Alison Greene-Barton RCST®, SEP, PPN and Beba facilitator offered sessions remotely via Zoom.

Sarah Theismann MA, CMP, SEP was added as a BEBA facilitator and started cofacilitating sessions via zoom with Alison and Tara. We are grateful to have her as a facilitator in the team.

India Leigh, continued to be BEBA's Bookkeeper and Administrator. She continued to contribute part time to BEBA in charge of bookkeeping, payroll, billing, marketing, record keeping and initial family intake.

Cindy Barnum was an assistant for sessions online during the year.

Jessica Shride, Natalie Garvey, Lynn Korst and Sarah Grace participated in sessions with families online and Sarah Grace also participated in sessions in person in Ojai as a layer of support and as part of their training to become BEBA facilitators. We are delighted to announce that Alisha Musicant and Kate White were added as assistants to the team in the last part of 2022.

The board of directors in 2022 included Mary Jackson as President, Vicki Diloia as treasurer, Alexis Baxley as secretary, Heida DeBra, Moriah Melin and Tara Blasco.

Beba Research Project

During this year we published the book on the research done about the BEBA clinic. This was a retrospective study to determine how coming to BEBA had affected the 254 families involved in the program up until the beginning of the study in 2020. The study included an online questionnaire and personal interviews that provided a wealth of data to research these issues and educate the professional and public sectors about our findings. The study was completed in the Fall 2021. The research became a 222-page document that is now available to distribute to BEBA families, graduates of the Castellino training and supporters as a PDF at a very low cost at our website (If you are interested please visit our website at:
