



2025 BEBA Annual Report

During the year 2025 BEBA continued supporting families with in person sessions at the Ojai clinic in California as well as with Zoom or phone sessions for families in other areas of the country and the world. Families attend sessions for as long as they want/need to resolve issues and traumatic imprinting and to explore effective parenting skills so they can continue on their own with occasional support.

Family Sessions at the BEBA Clinics

BEBA Facilitators provided a total of 66 sessions in 2025 (82 sessions in 2024) averaging 65 minutes.

- The BEBA clinic provided 66 sessions in 2025.
31 of those sessions were provided by Tara Blasco from the Ojai BEBA clinic (16 on Zoom and 15 in person)
The rest of the sessions, 35, were provided online by the other three facilitators.

The family clinic continues operating on a sliding scale between \$75/hour and \$160/hour. Clients were charged an average of \$100/ hour.

11 families came to BEBA in 2025 (19 in 2024): 12 children and their parents. 6 of these families started in 2025. Between January 1993, when BEBA was founded, and Dec 31, 2025, BEBA has served a total of 315 families.

Demographics of Families in the Family Clinic

The following is a breakdown of families seen in 2025 by annual income:

- 41% of the sessions were with families with annual incomes between \$60,000 to \$75,000.
- 22% of the sessions were with families with annual incomes between \$75,000 to \$100,000.
- 37% of the sessions were with families with annual incomes between \$100,000 to \$160,000.

Community Outreach

During the month of November Mary Jackson, president of BEBA, and Tara Blasco, director of the clinic went to Japan to teach a workshop on Sequencing. The course was well attended with 50 participants. There was a lot of interest on the BEBA clinic and we were delighted to see that participants had bought the book and started a study group to understand the skills and approach BEBA uses to support families.

Teaching Platform

BEBA handled the Castellino Fund created to support educational activities offered on the Castellino Online Teaching Platform. In 2025 the platform offered three Life Connections webinars: The Prenatal Shadow with Cherionna Menzam-Sills, It's Never Too Late to Heal with Rebecca Thompson Hitt and Healing from the Inside Out with Leslie Petruk. There were also two miniseries: The Prenatal Shadow and Healing from the Inside Out offered on the platform. The Castellino Fund helps support the platform and finances the free talks offered in it.

Ojai Clinic

Since September 2004, BEBA has operated a clinic in Ojai at the home of BEBA Facilitator, Director and Board Member, Tara Blasco. Tara offered sessions there during the year. The rent for this branch of BEBA is provided free of charge. It consists of a playroom complete with gym mats, tunnels, toys, pillows etc.

Clinical Staff

The clinical staff included 11 people: 1 Clinic Director, 4 Facilitators, 1 Bookkeeper &

Administrator, and 5 Volunteer Videographers/Layer of support facilitators.

Our beloved Raymond Castellino, D.C., RCST® co-founder and co-director of the BEBA clinic passed away on December 13, 2020. We miss him immensely and have continued doing the work to support families that he so beautifully developed over the years.

Tara Blasco, Ph.D., RCST® is the solo Director offering her services in this capacity on a volunteer basis. Tara Blasco continued being a paid facilitator offering sessions at the Ojai clinic and online.

Alison Greene-Barton RCST®, SEP, PPN and BEBA facilitator offered sessions remotely via Zoom. She also opened a branch of the BEBA clinic in the East Coast in Amherst (Massachusetts) where she just started to offer sessions to families in person and is planning to increase this offering as part of the BEBA clinic.

Sarah Theismann MA, CMP, SEP BEBA facilitator that has started co-facilitating sessions via zoom with Alison and Tara. We are grateful to have her as a facilitator in the team.

Frank Carbone RCST, PPN facilitator and continuum teacher had to take a break this year for medical reasons. We expect him to see families in 2026.

Cindy Barnum was added to the team as a facilitator for sessions online at the end of 2024.

India Leigh, continued to be BEBA's Bookkeeper and Administrator. She continued to contribute part time to BEBA in charge of bookkeeping, payroll, billing, marketing, record keeping and initial family intake.

Jessica Shride, Maritza Luz Vega, Lynn Korst, Kate White and Sarah Grace participated in sessions with families online and Sarah Grace, and Maritza Luz Vega also participated in sessions in person in Ojai as a layer of support and as part of their training to become BEBA facilitators.

The board of directors in 2025 included Mary Jackson as President, Vicki Diloia as treasurer, Alexis Baxley as secretary, Heidi Debra, Moriah Mellin and Tara Blasco.

Beba Research Project

We continued distributing the retrospective BEBA research study on how coming to BEBA has affected the 254 families involved in the program over the years from 1993 through 2020. This study has become the book titled "Supporting families to integrate their birth experiences" that is now available at Amazon as well as on our website

We expect the clinic to continue growing and serving families in the Ojai, Santa Barbara area, as well as Amherst, MA and online for other parts of the country and the world during the coming years.
